

AUTOMATED RUBBISH COLLECTION



The City will provide each household with a 96 gallon cart with a serial number assigned to your specific house. On your collection day, put your **household trash** in bags and place the rubbish in your new container and roll to the curb. Your cart should be placed no more than 3 feet from the curb and away from obstructions such as hydrants, mailboxes, trees, parked cars, utility poles, etc. If at all possible, try not to park on the street on your collection day. Please put the container at least 3-5 feet from your recycle cart and compost.

What to Place in Your Container:

our new container is equipped to handle regular household garbage in bags. By placing your rubbish in bags it will help prevent loose garbage from flying around and causing litter to collect on the street. Put bags in the container making sure that nothing hangs down the side and you are able to close the lid. Do not over stuff the container to the extent that the lid will not close. **Do not put bags on top of your container.**

Do not put the following items in your rubbish container:

With the City of Brooklyn in fully automated capacity, our Special Pick-Up policy has changed. Special pick-ups are only on **Friday**. **There are NO special pick-ups during a shortened week for a holiday.** If you have a special pick-up please contact the Service Garage at 216-635-4232 no later than 3 PM on Thursday with the type of items that you will have for pick-up. **Note the day and time to call in for a pick-up has changed from Friday to Thursday.** All calls for a pick-up that are received on Friday will be scheduled for the following week provided that there is no holiday.

Special Pick-Up items can be placed on the tree lawn on Thursday prior to pick-up no EARLIER than 5:00 PM and no later than 7:00 AM of the Friday pick-up.

Special Pick-Up materials include large items that will not fit into your container, i.e. furniture, televisions, doors, carpet, windows, appliances, and fencing. Remember if it does not fit in your container then it will be regular trash.

Construction and Demolition materials, concrete, plaster, batteries, tires, oil, gasoline, and antifreeze must be dropped off at the Service Garage at 9400 Memphis Avenue between the hours of 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM.

No items will be picked up from contractors who are performing work at your residence. Contractors are responsible for getting rid of their waste from the job.

Compost material is not a special pick-up item. All compost must wait for the next collection day and be removed from the tree lawn.

In conjunction with the CCSWD the City of Brooklyn also offers tire and computer recycling. Tires and computers can be dropped off at the Service Department between the hours of 7:30-3:30. These items will not be picked up on the curb. In 2014 the City recycled 14.03 tons of computers, HHW and tires.
