

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
CITY OF BROOKLYN CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION
TUESDAY, MARCH 22, 2011 3:30 PM**

Meeting called to order at 3:30 p.m.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairperson Dan Enovitch, Commissioner Deborah Gamble and Commissioner Sonia Brown.

MEMBERS ABSENT: None.

Acting Secretary Haig contacted Melinda Holmes, Pat Ramsey of Ramsey and Associates, Christine McGee-Hall of Daniel T. Clancey and Associates, and Paul Michalko of Personnel Selection Services. Melinda Holmes was pleased to be included in the request but unfortunately does not currently do any entry level testing. Proposals from the remaining three companies were discussed by the Commission. Although each company did have their own pricing schedule all were within the same price range.

The Commission asked Finance Director Dennis Kennedy of the likelihood of adding any patrol officers to the current force. Director Kennedy stated that as things are today there are adequate resources to add but that he is not aware of the hiring bodies specific intentions.

Commissioner Gamble asked Law Director Claussen to again get clarification from the Mayor on the number of patrol officers he plans to hire.
