



RULES ON USAGE OF FIRE HYDRANTS

1. Permission, in writing, shall be obtained from the Brooklyn Fire Chief, or his fire prevention designee.
2. Approval from the City of Cleveland, Division of Water is required.
3. The hydrant user shall be responsible for any, and all, damage incurred while using the hydrant. The cost of repairs, of any such damage, shall be borne by the hydrant user in whole. A fire hydrant wrench **must** be used when opening and/or closing any fire hydrant.
4. If usage will affect traffic or safety on public roadways and/or properties, the Brooklyn Police Department shall be advised, by the user, prior to use.
5. The user is responsible for the notification of affected residents (as to the possibility of discolored water) from the usage. This notification shall be given one full day in advance and can be either in person or through written notification,
