Parents think from 1-4pm the children would be supervised. The cost would be normally be\$5.00 to swim and skate but we also are providing a lunch so \$10.00. We need an emergency ordinance. The 1st reading would be in November. The dates of December 29 and January 2 were suggested since Brooklyn doesn't get out until December 22. Ryan said he would promote it and the students could buy the tickets at school. These dates would be Pre-New Years and Post-New Years. It would still be open to the public. If it is a success, we could do it again during Easter Break.

This is not Brooklyn program but Brooklyn Youth Hockey Association. They rent from us but run their own program.


