Chairman Van Kirk called the meeting to order.

The Mayor wished to discuss items with the Committee regarding: backup to power outage, animal trapping, new police station, and Parma Regional Dispatch Center (PRDC).

Mayor Gallagher said she had e-mailed information from Chief Mielke for backup traffic signal proposal, ranging from \$88,000-\$104,000 (dependant on priorities). We cannot have the safety issues at our major traffic signal locations without providing backup. It will be presented to Council.

It was briefly discussed the continued need for a new Police Station. It was agreed a new assessment needs to be done.

There was brief discussion about the Parma Regional Dispatch Center (PRDC) and addressing any complaints or issues and to discuss with Council on the direction to go in the future.
