

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY OF BROOKLYN CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 21, 2018 5:00**

Meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chairman Joe Magrey, Commissioner Rivera and Commissioner Larry Hull.

MEMBERS ABSENT: None.

MOTION by Chairman Magrey, second by Commissioner Hull to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held Wednesday, February 21, 2018.

Acting Secretary Haig gave a review of the applicants for the firefighter/paramedic entrance exam being held on March 22.
