### **Greater Cleveland Shelter Info:**

- Meg discussed her tour with Laura's Home, a women's shelter in Greater Cleveland that services women who are homeless (with or without children) for a variety of reasons, including but not limited to Domestic Abuse. They are experiencing over a year wait list. Further discussion was about homeless shelters and the wait lists that most have.
