

Solicitors and Peddlers WebCheck Information

The City of Brooklyn requires a criminal background check prior to the issuance of a Peddler's or Solicitor's license and permit. The Ohio Attorney General's Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) regularly processes about a million background checks a year. BCI completes such background checks by comparing fingerprints received against a database of criminal fingerprints to determine if there is a criminal record. All fingerprints must be submitted to BCI electronically through WebCheck.

BCI then issues a background report that is **sent directly to the Chief of Police** of the Brooklyn Police Department.
