The Mayor's Court Clerk can assist you with the following items:

- Finding information regarding your case – date, time and where to appear
- Rescheduling court dates
- Answer questions regarding fees that are owed to the court

The Mayor's Court Clerk cannot assist you with the following items:

- Give legal advice or opinions
- Tell you how to plea
- Advise you how the magistrate may rule

How to Pay Your Fine

If your ticket is waivable, you may pay your ticket before the court date. Payments are accepted in the form of cash, money order, personal check, all major credit cards or online at www.ohioticketpayments.com

Proof of Insurance and Financial Responsibility

All drivers must provide proof of insurance. If insurance was not shown at the time of your citation, you must provide proof with your payment or at your court appearance. The effective date of coverage must cover the date the citation was issued.
